Section 112 - Localism Act 2011

Dear John,

I write in relation to the Bridlington AAP which is currently being examined following submission on 21st April 2011.

You will be aware that section 112 of the Localism Act 2011 will come into force on 15 January. Section 112(6) of the 2011 Act states that the amendments made to section 20(7) and 23(2) and (3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 apply 'in relation to all adoptions of development plan documents that take place after [January 15], including an adoption where steps in relation to the document have taken place before then'.

This means that any plan currently being examined - at any stage prior to adoption - will be subject to the new provisions from January 15.

The Inspector, via the programme officer, will be in contact with you shortly to outline any specific implications and action needed in relation to your examination.
