

WELCOME TO BRIDLINGTON PARK AND RIDE

This is an East Riding of Yorkshire Council Service operating during the summer season April to September from 9.00am to 5.45pm.

The Service is supported by both Coach and Land Train with an approximate turn round time of ten minutes, between a Coach or Land Train departing Bridlington, you can mix the service using either the Coach or the Land Train down to Bridlington and visa versa coming back.

The service is included in the parking fee, but individuals can pay a fee to use the service independent of parking a vehicle.

The Spa Light Express Land Train

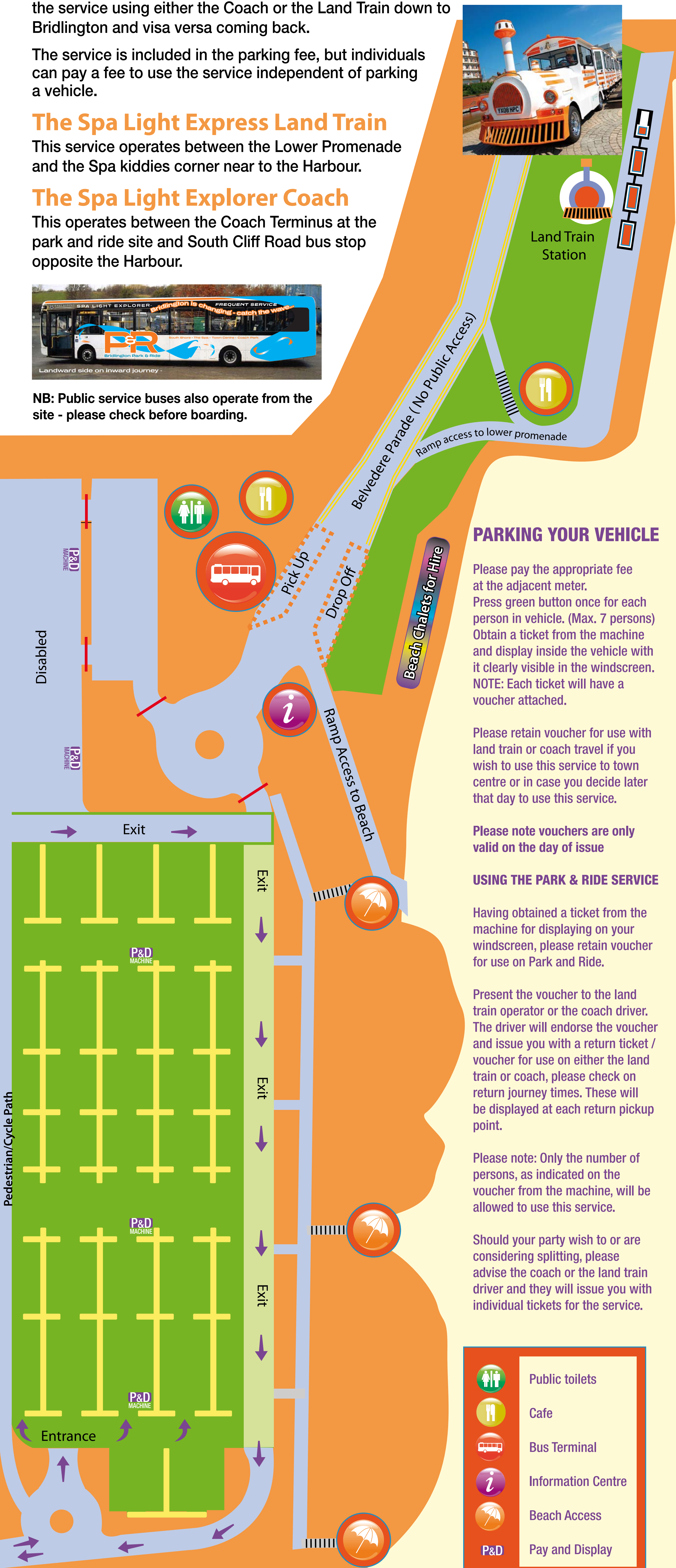
This service operates between the Lower Promenade and the Spa kiddies corner near to the Harbour.

The Spa Light Explorer Coach

This operates between the Coach Terminus at the park and ride site and South Cliff Road bus stop opposite the Harbour.



NB: Public service buses also operate from the site - please check before boarding.



PARKING YOUR VEHICLE

Please pay the appropriate fee at the adjacent meter. Press green button once for each person in vehicle. (Max. 7 persons) Obtain a ticket from the machine and display inside the vehicle with it clearly visible in the windscreen. NOTE: Each ticket will have a voucher attached.

Please retain voucher for use with land train or coach travel if you wish to use this service to town centre or in case you decide later that day to use this service.

Please note vouchers are only valid on the day of issue

USING THE PARK & RIDE SERVICE

Having obtained a ticket from the machine for displaying on your windscreen, please retain voucher for use on Park and Ride.

Present the voucher to the land train operator or the coach driver. The driver will endorse the voucher and issue you with a return ticket / voucher for use on either the land train or coach, please check on return journey times. These will be displayed at each return pickup point.

Please note: Only the number of persons, as indicated on the voucher from the machine, will be allowed to use this service.

Should your party wish to or are considering splitting, please advise the coach or the land train driver and they will issue you with individual tickets for the service.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE SITE
